WOMEN AND GIRLS FUND BEGINS ANNUAL FUNDRAISING CAMPAIGN

Waukesha, WI (October 26, 2016) - The Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County (WGF) has launched its annual campaign to raise support for programs that benefit women and girls in Waukesha County.

The WGF, established in 2004, seeks to aid and enrich the lives of women and girls so they become thriving residents of their communities. Each year, the WGF awards grants to local nonprofit agencies to support projects and programs that promote the welfare, independence and self-sufficiency of women and girls of all ages. Areas of interest include leadership, education, health and wellness, family and relationships, and arts and culture.

In 2016, the WGF awarded grants totaling \$95,000 to 10 local nonprofit agencies: The Association for the Rights of Citizens with Handicaps, Waukesha County Best Buddies School Friendship Program, Donna Lexa Art Centers, Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin, Girl Scouts of Wisconsin Southeast, Hope Center, the University of Wisconsin-Waukesha County Foundation, Waukesha Community Arts Project, Waukesha County Community Dental Clinic, and The Caring Place.

“We are proud to support the wonderful programs these agencies have developed to help guide women and girls to be contributing members of our community,” said Mary McNulty, chair of the WGF Board of Trustees. “A successful campaign will allow us to provide even more financial assistance to community groups that help women and girls build the confidence and skills they need to thrive.”
